

## OTHER INFORMATION

Parking and Traffic Arrangements- please observe the following:

- To ensure the smooth running of the carnival, all competitors and spectators are asked to observe the following:
- Cars towing boat trailers are asked to approach the clubhouse from the Boomerang Drive intersection with the Lakes Way, i.e. the southernmost intersection.
- Boats may be dropped off at the western carpark end of Elizabeth Beach and traffic marshals will direct you to trailer parking areas
- Cars not towing boat trailers may approach the clubhouse from the Lakeside Crescent intersection with the Lakes Way, i.e. the northernmost intersection, and park in the designated areas.
- All boats are to be launched from the boat ramp at the eastern carpark. Trailer parking is at the carpark west of the club.
- Traffic marshals will assist with directions.

## COMPETITION INFORMATION

- 6 rounds then a final for Open Men, Open Women, U23 Men, U23 Women, U19 Men, U19 Women.
- 4 rounds instead of 3 on Saturday (conditions permitting) for Open Men and Open Women.
- Reserve Men to be 5 rounds with top 12 progressing to a 6<sup>th</sup> round with top 6 points scorers progressing to final. (3 rounds Saturday).
- Masters Men and Masters Women will be 5 rounds and then a final.
- Round robin racing with top 6 crews on points through to finals.
- Tim Knight Club Relay to be completed on Saturday - heats after morning rounds and if not a straight final, then final last event Saturday.
- Every effort will be made for other crews to alternate ends.
- Crews will race in both areas – check your draws. Area 1 left, Area 2 right.
- Successful finalists will choose their preferred lanes in order of their round robin position.
- Compulsory team manager meeting at beginning of each block and before Tim Knight Club Relay at Recorders' tent.
- Count back - most number of firsts, then seconds then if still equal best result in last race, then best results when crews on same points clashed.
- Right of way at buoys? Leading crews have right of way unless they don't try to avoid incoming crew.
- Maximum time limit 10 minutes or 2 failures trying to negotiate the break to sea.
- Check your draw for division points.
- It is your responsibility to be on the line on time by following the program (not the check starters).
- PLEASE DON'T PROTEST!! Course judges will notify crews of loss of placings. For clarification check with sectional referee.
